Nina Vaca is founder, chairman and CEO of Pinnacle Group, a global workforce solutions provider, twice named the fastest-growing woman-owned company in the country. Vaca is one of the few Latinas in the nation serving on the boards of publicly traded companies and has been named in the top five of Fortune Magazine's 50 Most Powerful Latinas. In 2014, Vaca was appointed by the White House as a Presidential Ambassador for Global Entrepreneurship.

In addition to her business leadership, she has served as a civic leader and philanthropist, working relentlessly to expand opportunities for minorities and women in business. Vaca is a passionate civic leader and philanthropist with an emphasis on encouraging young people to get involved in STEM fields.
