<u>Self-sponsored students</u> are required to show evidence of resources on hand to cover the entire two-year program - US \$152,076. Students with dependents must also show evidence of resources to cover the costs of the dependents for two years as well.

<u>Sponsored students</u> must show evidence that their sponsors have resources to cover at least one academic year of the program - US \$76,038. For students with dependents, the sponsor must also show evidence of resources to cover the costs of the dependent for one academic year as well.

Students who receive scholarships or graduate assistant awards from TCU may reduce the amount of support to be proven by the amount of the award.

Instructions for the Financial Statement Form (next page)

Texas Christian University requires confirmation of financial resources from all applicants who are not United States citizens or who are not U.S. permanent residents. These Financial Statements must be on file in the Office of International Student Services before the required U.S. entry document is issued.

- The applicant must complete Part 1 and sign it. If self-sponsored, the applicant should write "self as the name of the sponsor and sign and date Part 2.
- The sponsor must sign and date Part 2. if the student is sponsored by an agency or government, such sponsorship must be verified by an attached official statement to that effect. The original document must be on file at TCU.
- If a student has more than one sponsor, the student and each sponsor must complete a separate form and indicate the amount of support in Part 2.
- An official of the sponsor's bank or other financial institution must either complete, sign, and affix the institution's official seal or stamp to Part 3 or provide a separate statement on the institution's letterhead indicating that based on the records of the sponsor named, the sponsor should be able to meet the expenses as noted above. A self-sponsored student must provide copies of all bank statements received during the past year, including the current balance, which must be sufficient to cover all expenses for the student's entire educational program.
- The applicant may submit the completed form either with the application or after receiving a letter of acceptance to
 the University. The Certificate of Eligibility required to obtain a student visa cannot be issued without proof
 of sufficient financial resources and sponsorship verification statements.
